REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY

When you registered, you initialed that you understood your non-refundable \$50. Registration Fee held your child's space in camp and goes towards your full tuition payment due on your child's first day of his/her registered camp week. If you notify us of changes on or before the Monday prior to your registered week, your Registration Fee is transferable to another future camp session at any location *this summer only*. Sorry, no refunds or make up days for missed camp days.

ARTWORK PICK-UP POLICY

All art work must be picked-up no later than 3 weeks from the last day of your camp week (except clay work...which is 3 months or less). Fine Art Starts is not responsible for keeping or storing artwork left longer than 3 weeks from session attended. Clay students will be contacted by email when it is ready for pick-up and will be given a deadline for pick up.

Forms to Return to us: Medical Form (above, p.1 & 2) must be completed before children can be admitted to camp, and Artsonia Release (above, p.3). Please bring your forms with you on the first day of your camp week. Campers will not be admitted without a completed Medical form. If you forget or lose your form, please be prepared to arrive at least 15 minutes before your scheduled camp time on Monday of your child's camp week to fill out paperwork on location.

To Contact Us During Camp Hours: To immediately reach us during camp hours, please use the phone numbers below. Please let the receptionist know if your call is urgent. If you leave a voice message or your call is not urgent, it will be returned between 4-5pm.

Confirmation Calls: You will not receive a confirmation call prior to your registered camp week unless we have questions for you regarding your registration or if the camp is full. Please call us to reserve early arrival/late pick up days.

Where to Park and Enter:

Oregon City Locations: Parents, to ensure the safety of your children on our busy street, we ask you walk your child(ren) and drop them off for camp *inside* the studio/school each camp day. Parking is limited at the Studio location, as we have only 3 assigned spaces and off-street parking. For this reason we ask you save the closest parking spot to the door for mothers with young siblings and/or infants in car seats. You may also park in the parking lot at Eastham School and take a stroll up to the studio. We ask, again, that parents *always* escort to and from class. Please enter through the front, main door (on Molalla) and check in at the front counter. There is a parking lot as well as off street parking at Park Place School. Enter through the main door and follow the signs to Fine Art Starts.

Lake Oswego / SW Portland Location: Parking is very limited at Touchstone School. On Monday you may park in the upper parking lot, where the main entrance to the school is located. If there are no spots left when you arrive, you may park on offstreet parking, just down the hill from the school. There is about a 1-block walk if you park below. On Tuesday through Friday students may be dropped off and picked up directly in front of the art building. Please make sure you have eye contact with the teacher and you communicate to them exactly who will be picking up that day. Directions on this convenience will be given to you on Monday of your camp week.

Happy Valley Locations: park in the main parking lot, enter through the main door, and walk straight ahead to the cafeteria area for check in and out each day.

What to Bring/Wear: Full Day students please bring a healthy lunch, snack, water bottle, light jacket (if it's overcast or cool), and sunscreen already applied. Cap or sun hat is also recommended. Half Day students please bring a snack, water bottle, and sunscreen already applied. Please don't wear anything you will regret getting paint on. Please write your child's name on everything, if possible.

When You Arrive on Monday: You and your child will be greeted and your child will receive a name tag. Please say goodbye to your child **before** entering the camp location. This makes a smooth departure for everyone. Please turn in your medical form (or fill out another if you forgot yours) and take care of your balance with cash or check. While you are doing this, a Studio Assistant will guide your child to the check-in circle with the other campers. **Please note: due to space limitations and distractions, parents may not stay for check-in with their children.** Our staff is highly experienced in assisting children to transitioning to the camp group.

Sign In/Sign Out: Please sign your child in and out each day. List any person (other than you) who may be picking up your child that particular day.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Policies: We expect most students arrive 10-15 minutes early on Monday of your camp week. The earliest your child may be dropped off to camp Tuesday through Friday is *5 minutes* prior to camp time. We will not be responsible for them before that time unless you have pre-arranged and paid for early arrival. We appreciate your promptness in picking your child up as well. We understand traffic is beyond your control. However, staff is still “on the clock” when you are late so you will be charged a pro-rated amount of \$5 for every 15 minutes you are late (with a 5 minute grace period) until you arrive. Payment by cash or check is due at the time of pick up.

Early Arrival/Late Pick-up: (Available only at Oregon City and Lake Oswego locations). Please make advance reservations if you will need to drop off you child early or pick him/her up late. You may schedule with us the day before you require early arrival or late pick up. If you require early arrival on Monday of your child's camp week, please contact us by Saturday night prior to the beginning of the camp week. This allows us time to accommodate your family's needs. Cost is \$8/hr. or \$4/half-hr. Campers may arrive as early as 8:00am and depart as late as 5:00pm, with even further extended care options at the Lake Oswego / Portland location.

How Many Students in Each Group?: There are 10 students in each group. There is a maximum of 3 groups per camp week...totaling as many as 30 campers/week. Please remember each group only has 10 campers in it...although you may see many more campers of various ages checking in on the first day of camp.

My Child is Advanced...Can He/She Be With Older Kids?: Students will be grouped according to their age unless the registrants' ages are remarkably different, which is beyond our control. We do our very best to ensure your child is grouped according to his or her needs and preferences. Even with groups of children who are the same age, their artistic abilities and social skills can be incredibly diverse. One of our goals is to make sure each child is challenged according to his/her capabilities, that the week is fun and they feel special here.

Can Parents Stay?: Since we may have many students checking in at once, parents are not allowed to stay after checking in their children. However, you may visit your child's studio classroom on Wednesday Parent Day (see below). We anticipate most students may not know anyone on Monday and may be a little nervous to see you go. Fortunately they are in experienced hands and our Staff will help your child easily transition into the group with the others. In their small groups they may make friends in a short period of time. Reassuring your child of this may ease his/her anxiousness. *If your child is extremely upset for more than 10 minutes after you leave, we will contact you by phone immediately.* If it's been a 'rocky separation', we will call you within the first hour to let you know how your child is doing.

“Timid” Campers: If your child is overly shy or timid and hesitant to let you leave, please let us know on the Special Request Form so we can pair him/her with a partner right away on Monday morning. Children are usually fine as soon as parents go (though at the moment they may beg you to stay)! We know this is hard, but please let your child know what to expect on Monday morning *before* their camp begins. It also helps if you arrive early and on time and say goodbye *before* you reach the front door. We appreciate your compliance and hope you'll visit your child's studio on Wednesday Parent Day. Again, if your child is upset for more than 10 minutes after you leave, we will call you!

Wednesday Parent Day!: Curious to see what your child is creating? You may visit with your child and Instructor for 15 minutes in the studio classroom before your child's camp time ends on Wednesday.

Art Show and Taking Artwork Home: Your child's art show will be held on Friday of his/her camp week from 11:40-12pm (AM Campers), and 3:40-4:00pm (Full Day & PM Campers)..(Happy Valley 11:40-12:00 & 2:40-3:00pm). This is a time for your child to shine! Please support your child by being on time and taking interest in what they've accomplished in just one week! Ask questions! All students may take all art home at the completion of the art show on Friday. Any students with unfired clay will be notified by email 6-8 weeks after their session. Please be patient...clay's characteristics don't allow us to “speed dry” projects...and they must all go through *two* firings before they are complete.

What about Fall Classes? Fall after-school classes begin September 6th and are held in Oregon City and at various public and private schools. We have classes for children beginning at age 4, and running up through High School. Do you want more fine art at your school? We'd love to visit your child's school!
